Important topics discussed:

- 1. Prime minister Sri Narendra Modi spoke about the importance of 5G for the country and the role being played by the country in the development and implementation of 5G technology.
- 2. Prime Minister Modi began his speech by highlighting that the launch of 5G services in the country is an example of India's ability and capabilities.
- 3. "5G brings the dawn of a new era to the country. 5G is the beginning of immense opportunities for the country. I congratulate each Indian for this," added Modi.
- **4. 4 Pillars of Digital India:** Cost of Devices, Digital Connectivity Cost of Data, Idea of Digital First.
- 5. Mukesh Ambani and Sunil Mittal announced the rollout of 5G services for Reliance Jio and Airtel, respectively.
- 6. The PM also highlighted that 5G would benefit not only urban areas but also students in rural schools, villages and even poor labourers in the country.
- 7. Narendra Modi also spoke about how India is playing a key role in developing new technologies and is not just a consumer anymore.
- 8. Narendra Modi also said that India was dependent on other countries for 2G, 3G and 4G technologies. However, the country is not dependent on other countries for 5G.
- 9. Modi also revealed that as part of the government's Make in India push, the mobile manufacturing units in India have gone up from 2 units in 2014 to over 200 units in 2022.
- 10. "In India, an average mobile user uses 14 GB of data per month. In 2014, the cost of this 14GB data was around ₹ 4,200 per month. The cost of the same data is around ₹ 125 to 150. This means an average user is saving around ₹ 4,000 per month," said Modi.
