
Dowry



Alimony

1. After registration, all participants will be added to an official group for updates, scheduling and coordination.
2. Each debating team will consist of 2-3 members, assigned after registration.
3. The debate will be conducted in multiple rounds, depending on the no. of participants.
4. The points will be given individually to each participant on the basis of their debating skill.
5. Judge's decision will be final and binding on all participants.
6. Stepping back or withdrawing at the last moment is strictly not allowed.
7. Participants must report to the venue at least 30 minutes before the event to ensure the debate begins sharply at 1:00 PM.
8. Participants are advised to come well-prepared to avoid nervousness, hesitation, or stage fear.
9. Maintain decorum, respect, and discipline throughout the event. Any form of misconduct will lead to disqualification.
10. Winner & Runner-up will receive awards, and all other participation.

JUDGING CRITERION


Each participant was judged individually based on:




