1) INTERVIEWER: Tell us something about yourself.

SHIVARAM: Hello, this is Shivaram Reddy. I graduated from J.B. Institute of Engineering and Technology in the year 2022 under the course of Bachelor's of Technology of Electronics and Computer Engineering. I am currently working as a software engineer with Sapiens InfoTech Private Limited.

2) INTERVIEWER: How do you feel now that we are going to make you reminisce about your college days?

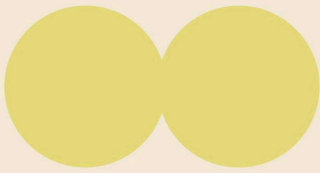
SHIVARAM: Well, it feels really good and quite surreal. Honestly, I never thought I would be getting a call from my college someday. It will be really great to remember those good old days.

3) INTERVIEWER: During your study years in JBIET could you tell us about your experiences there that helped to make yourself successful in the career you chose?

SHIVARAM: There are quite a lot of things I have experienced throughout the four years of my college days. Of course the first year was quite strict and academic oriented. The whole year was to make our base strong and prepare us for the next 3 years. The next two years we had to restrain ourselves because that was the time when the pandemic hit and we had to attend our classes through our laptops. And the fourth year we utilised it for the major and minor projects and then for internships. Finally we made ourselves prepare for the placements.

4) INTERVIEWER: Considering the academic environment at JBIET, can you highlight a course or project that you initially found challenging but ultimately played a crucial role in your skill development and career trajectory?

SHIVARAM: I was under the ECM branch so the major course I had to take up was Computer science. Under that i tried to improve myself with C language, python<sup>10</sup> and Java. I took up many online courses from the NPTEL website, which our college has suggested to us.



5) INTERVIEWER: In a rapidly changing job market, adaptability is the key. Can you discuss a situation during your college years where you had to quickly adapt to unexpected changes, and how did it shape your ability to thrive in your current professional role?

SHIVARAM: Adaptability was not a problem with me. I really admired changes. I have always tried to be unique, trying things out of boundaries. Whenever I was bound to a sudden change, I tried to take up the necessity of the change and learn the ways in which I can adapt to the change. It helped me a lot because when there is a sudden change of plans in my workplace, I can adapt myself to the change and contribute myself accordingly rather than panicking over the situation. So, I think adaptability is going to be a big section for work performance.

6) INTERVIEWER: JBIET College is known for its collaborative culture. Can you share an example of a group project or collaboration that pushed you out of your comfort zone, and how did it contribute to your personal and professional growth?

SHIVARAM: Of course collaboration is one of the main trends in JBIET. And I think it's a very statistic plan which is quite advantageous in many aspects. There are many internships that will push u quite out of your comfort zone but it is also going to help you to get yourself prepared for the real corporate world where comfort is not a much known thing. Taking part in these internships I got a very accord experience on how it feels to be working in offices and how u get to prepare yourself to learn many new things.

7) INTERVIEWER: JBIET's alumni network is known for its strength. How have you leveraged your connections with fellow alumni to enhance your career, and can you share an example of a mentorship or collaboration that proved valuable in your journey?





SHIVARAM: I had a very good friend circle. As said communication is the key to everything. It helps you learn about new things and trends. We were also in touch with our seniors who helped us a lot about placements and sorting out things which was going to help us a lot when it comes to being engineers.

8) INTERVIEWER: Since you said u had to spend two years of your college time at home because of the pandemic. Did it pose as a disadvantage to you because you were only able to engage virtually with your college and not being present there physically?

SHIVARAM: When a pandemic hits, it's only normal to have disadvantages because a lot of things slow down to zero. But it has its own advantages too. Time can be one of the most important advantages during lockdowns. I could make myself a lot of free time where I could learn more things. I took a lot of online courses which could not have been possible if we had classes and assignments. These online courses helped a lot in the future and it also added experience to my resume. So on one point, to me, it was more advantageous than being a disadvantage.

9) INTERVIEWER: Reflecting on your journey from JBIET to your current position in Delhi, what advice would you give to current students aspiring to achieve success in their academic and professional pursuits?

SHIVARAM: Focus. Focus is always the greatest of all advices we ever get. While being a good student when it comes to academics, try making yourself excellent on practical things. When you try to bring out the level best of yourself in any field you opt, it's not very hard to succeed. Being concentrated and devoted is all u need. Also courage. Keeping a positive attitude of "I can do it" is important too.

10) INTERVIEWER: Getting onto one personal question I would like to ask you. If u had to chance where u were sent back to time, would u have done things differently than u did then?

SHIVARAM: Definitely. As an alumnus, if I was given the chance to go back in time, I would certainly have made some different choices. I would work upon the aspects of my academic and personal development which I always wanted to improve with the benefit of the experience I have gained.

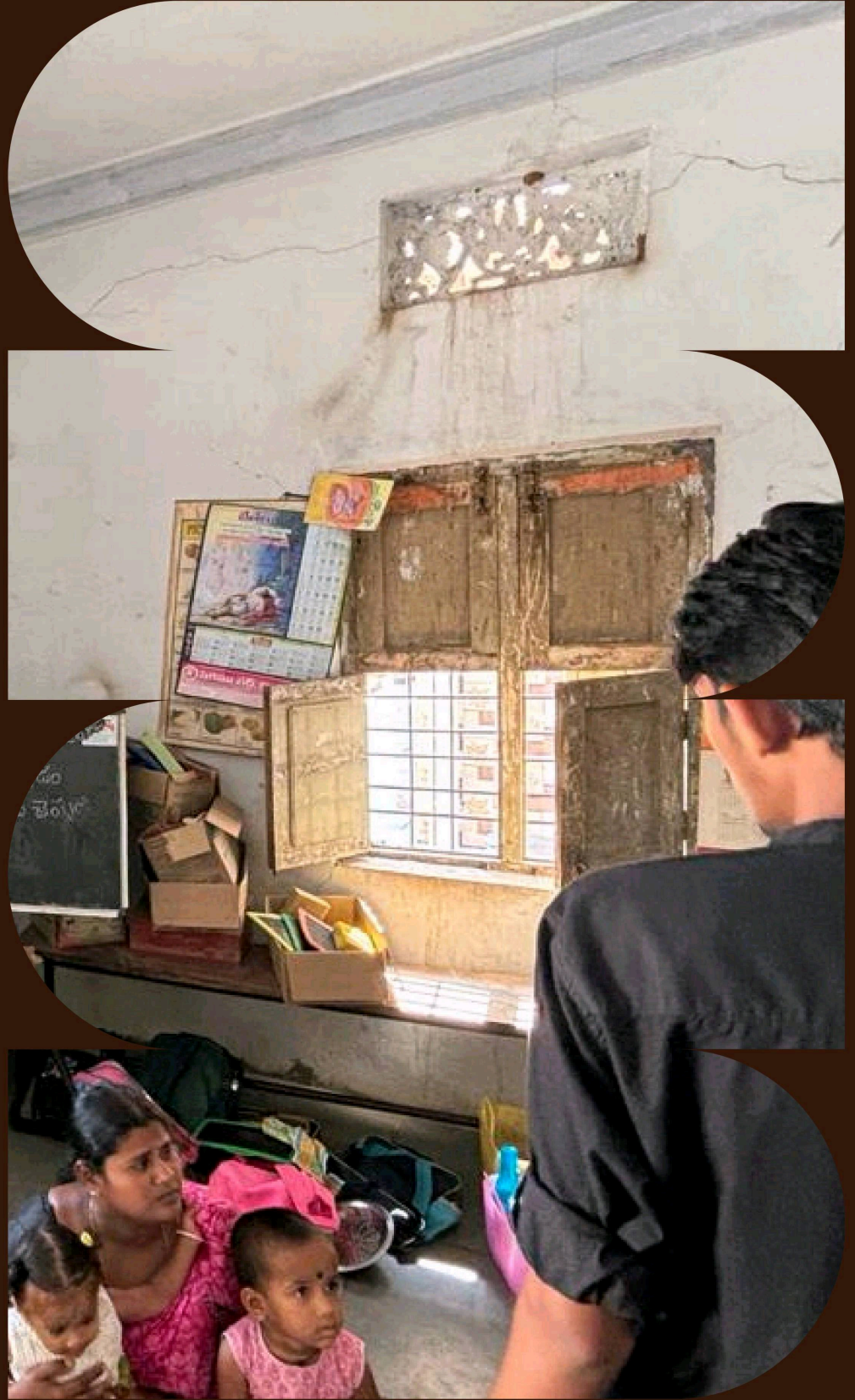

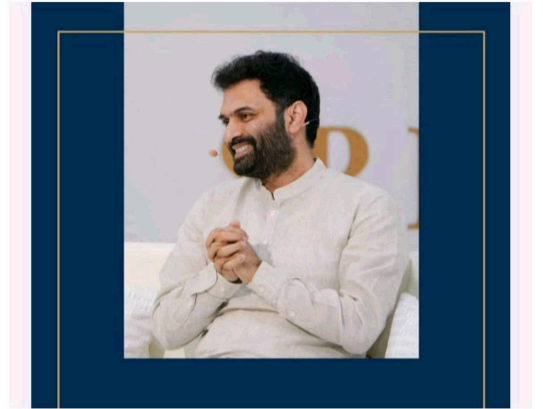

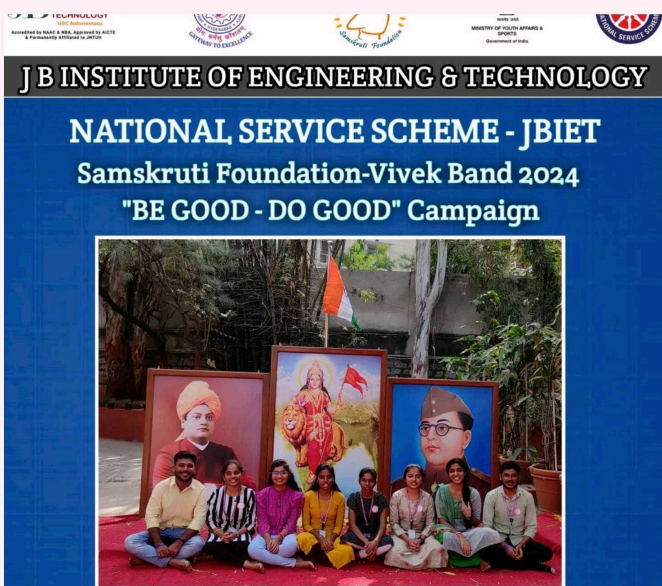

There is no time to stand and stare.





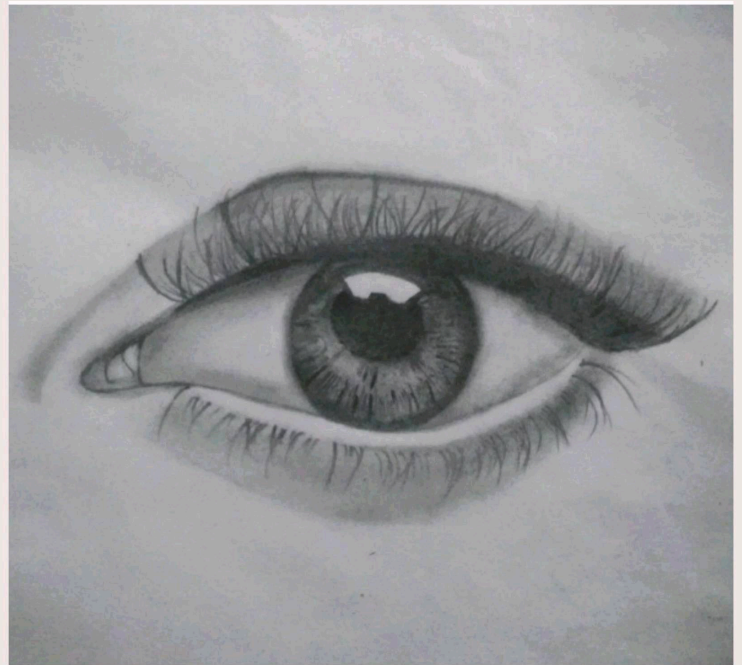
